

NAMES OF GOD—Scripture Memorization

- ABBA

For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father" Romans 8:15 [NKJV]

As you memorize this verse, call out to your Abba-Father in praise and thanksgiving .
"Abba" actually means "Daddy"

- ALMIGHTY GOD

"I am Almighty God; walk before Me and be blameless." Genesis 17:1

Almighty God in Hebrew is "El Shaddai" Pause to praise God for being Almighty, which means having absolute power over all. He is not limited, nothing is beyond His capacity, He is above all yet He walks with us. Remember, whatever person or problem comes against you today, Almighty God is greater !

- AUTHOR

*"...the Author of eternal salvation..." and "...the Author and finisher of our faith..."
Hebrews 6:9 and Hebrews 12:2*

God is the Author of our faith and salvation. God wrote it, created it, caused it to come into being. As you memorize these two short verses pause to praise our Author for what He has done for us spiritually. He, as an Author, has written His name on our hearts,(Jer.31:33) and inscribed our names on the palms of His hand.(Isaiah 49:16) Let's pause to praise Him for that !

- BRANCH

A Branch of righteousness; Jeremiah 33:15

Because I lived in the country growing up, I used to climb trees a lot, so when I think of a branch I think of something to grab onto and cling to. This is the way I would like to think of God as I pause to praise His name. Let's praise Him for being our Branch of righteousness, a Branch who is always there to cling to, a Branch who is always upright.

- COUNSELOR

"And His name will be called....Counselor..." Isaiah 9:6

We have a Wonderful Counselor given to us to help us understand our problems and work through the solutions. He is available 24 hours a day. We need not worry about the fees because He has paid the price for us to come to Him. He will represent us, teach us and always set us free. He is our personal Counselor !

- CREATOR

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. So God created man in His own image; ...male and female He created them. Genesis 1:1 & 1:27

As you memorize these great scripture truths pause and praise your Creator God and commit yourself to Him who created you and all things.

- DELIVERER

The LORD is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer; My God, my strength, in whom I will trust; Psalm 18:2

As you memorize this scripture, pause to praise the Lord as your Deliverer.

- EL-ROI (meaning "God who sees me")

"The she called on the name of the Lord who spoke to her, You-Are-the-God-Who-Sees;..." Genesis 16:13

As you memorize this verse pause to praise Him who sees all and sees us. No matter where we are today He sees us, we are not insignificant to Him. Anytime you feel alone remember this verse and call on your EL-ROI--the God Who Sees !

- ETERNAL GOD

The eternal God is your refuge; Deuteronomy 33:27

God is forever-He will forever be our refuge. Let's praise Him now for His eternal love and care.

- FAITHFUL & TRUE

Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse, And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, Revelation 19:11

You can always count on someone who is faithful and true. They are always there for you. They stick by you in good times and bad. God is like that. That is one of His names. As you memorize this verse take time to pause to praise God that He is called Faithful and True.

- GUIDE

For this is God, Our God forever and ever, He will be our Guide even to death. Psalm 48:14

We need not fear if God is our Guide. He will never lead us astray. This week as we memorize this verse, let's pause to praise Him as our Guide and follow Him wherever He leads.

- HOPE

...looking for the blessed Hope.... Titus 2:3

With God there is always hope, because He is Hope! Today let us pause to praise Him for being our Hope as we memorize this short verse.

- I AM

And God said to Moses "I AM WHO I AM" And He said "Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, I AM has sent me to you." Exodus 3:14

This is God's name showing He is in the present--He is here now. He always was and always will be As we memorize this verse, let's pause to praise Him for being with us right now, for being our I AM.

- JEHOVAH

"Trust in the Lord for ever; for in the Lord JEHOVAH is everlasting strength..." Isaiah 26:4

JEHOVAH is the personal, revealed name of God translated from the Hebrew consonants YHWH. As you memorize this verse, pause to praise Him who He is and what He does for You.

- JUDGE

*For the Lord is our Judge, the Lord is our Lawgiver, the Lord is our King, He will save us.
Isaiah 33:22*

The Lord is our Judge---not satan, not the world, not our friends, not our family, not ourselves.....the Lord is our Judge !! What is a Judge? It should be someone who is honest, fair, wise and just. Let us praise God that He is all that for us--a righteous Judge ! He is compassionate, loving and fair! He knows our heart. *"Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need."* Hebrews 4:16

- KING

Behold, your King is coming to you, He is just and having salvation Zechariah 9:9

It matters not what we may not have on this earth, what matters is that we do have a King in Heaven! As you memorize this verse, pause to praise Him for being your King and rejoice that someday you will join Him in His heavenly kingdom !

- LAWGIVER

"There is one Lawgiver who is able to save and to destroy." James 4:12

A lawgiver is a lawmaker or legislator. In the world we see lawgivers in our government, we elect legislators or lawmakers to represent us in Congress. There may be many men and women who make the laws of our country. But, in the spiritual, God is our Lawgiver. *"The Lord is our Lawgiver,..." Isaiah 33:22.* God is the ultimate Lawgiver. God makes all the rules we are to live by. Let's praise Him who is our Lawgiver this week as we memorize this verse.

- LOVE

...God is Love 1 John 4:8

What exactly is Love? 1 Corinthians 13:4-8 tells us: *Love suffers long and is kind,...rejoices in the truth; bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. What exactly is Love not? love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up; does not behave rudely, does not seek it's own, is not provoked, thinks no evil; does not rejoice in iniquity, Love never fails.*

God is Love, so let's think about what He is and what He is not. As we memorize this short verse this week, let's pause to praise God for who He is !---LOVE. He will never fail!

- MAN OF SORROWS

*"He was despised and rejected by men, A Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief."
Isaiah 53:3*

The Lord is acquainted with grief, He knows sorrow. He can relate to our sorrows and sadness. He knows how it feels to be rejected or despised. This week as we memorize this verse, let's pause to praise Him who can relate to us in anything we are going through.

- MERCIFUL

"For I am Merciful..."says the Lord, "I will not keep My anger forever." Jeremiah 3:12

In this verse the Lord is telling Jeremiah to proclaim these words to Israel to repent and return to Him because He was Merciful. He was declaring His name: "I AM MERCIFUL" As you memorize this short verse , pause to praise God for being Merciful. Praise Him for being kind, compassionate and forgiving now through Christ our Savior. Thank Him that one of His names is "Merciful"

"The Lord is gracious and full of compassion, slow to anger and great in mercy." Psalm 145:8

- MIGHTY ONE

You shall know that I, the LORD, am your Savior And your Redeemer,. the Mighty One of Jacob. Isaiah 60:16

God is someone of superior power or strength, great in importance, exceptional! All these words and more describe the Mighty One--our God! As we memorize this verse let's pause to give Him our praise and thanksgiving for who He is. *The LORD your God in your midst, The Mighty One, will save; He will rejoice over you with gladness, He will quiet [you] with His love, He will rejoice over you with singing."* Zephaniah 3:17

- OUR PEACE

" For He Himself is our Peace," Ephesians 2:14

What a wonderful scripture to memorize and keep in mind especially in our hectic world today! Next time you are facing un-rest or chaos in your life, I hope this scripture will be recalled to your mind so you can remember that He is your Peace and then you will be able to stand in that and find the peace you need to comfort you during any difficult times in your life As you memorize this verse pause to praise Him who is our Peace. *"Now may the Lord of peace Himself give you peace always in every way. The Lord be with you all."* 2 Timothy 3:16

- POTTER

We are the clay, and You our Potter; Isaiah 64:8

God is in control, we are in His hands. Every day the Lord is molding and making us into a useful vessel He can use for His glory. As we memorize this verse let's pause to praise our Potter for what He is doing in our lives to make us more like Him.

- PURIFIER

"He will sit as a Refiner and a Purifier of silver..." Malachi 3:3

God wants to cleanse us and make us free from anything in our lives that might keep us from being pure and holy. A Refiner and a Purifier remove all the imperfections in something to make it better. Sometimes when things are removed it is hard to see the why of it. Removal causes change and change is sometimes hard to accept. Removal can also hurt or be uncomfortable. But if God is doing the removing we can be sure the end result will be for our good. and for something that will make us better spiritually. As we memorize this verse let's take the time to pause and praise God for the purifying He is doing in our lives.

- ROCK

He is the Rock, his works are perfect, and all his ways are just. Deuteronomy 32:4

God is our Rock, a firm foundation, One who cannot be moved. He is perfect. All His ways are just. What a source of strength we have! Memorize this verse so you will remember it in your time of need. Then, take time to pause and praise Him who is our Rock

- RULER

"the Ruler over the kings of the earth" Revelation 1:5

God is in control, of all things, of all places, and of all people. He is great and mighty, yet, He is not too great that He cannot be personally involved in our lives. As you commit this verse to memory, pause to praise Him who is Ruler of all, great and small, and yet, who also, is the personal Ruler of our life. and...*"and let the peace of God rule in your hearts..." Colossians 3:15*

- SHIELD

I am your Shield, Genesis 15:1

A shield protects us. It shelters us from harm. What better one could we have than God? Memorize this verse as a reminder that He is your Shield, the One who protects you daily.

- TEACHER

You call Me Teacher and Lord, and you say well, for so I am. John 13:13

All the answers to life's problems are found in Him. As we memorize this verse let's pause to praise Him for being our Teacher, One who will show us all things and lead us in wisdom and truth.

- TRUTH

I...am...the Truth John 14:6

Pilate said: "What is truth?" He was looking right at it and didn't know it. Truth is that which is reliable, trustworthy, and consistent. Jesus was Truth in human form. Truth can make us free, sanctify us, purify us, and establish us. Belief in Jesus guarantees us all of the above, because He is Truth. "and you shall know the Truth, and the Truth shall make you free. John 8:32

- WAY

"I am the Way..." Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me. John 14:6

He is our hope and our direction. We need only to accept and follow Him and we won't be lost. Let's pause to praise Him for being our Way. Memorize this verse to share with those who don't yet know Him.
